VENUE DESCRIPTION

Headrow House is a varied venue with a Beer Hall, restaurant and roof terrace hosting regular arts and music events. Headrow House has step free access throughout the venue, with the exception of the Kennedy Meadows upper roof terrace. Each floor can be accessed via a lift, which can be found in the main entrance. There is 1 accessible toilet within the building, which can be accessed via the lift or stairs. The disabled access toilet has grab rails and an alarm, in case you may need any assistance. There are also baby changing facilities in the toilet and it is open at all times. The main entrance to access Ox Club is step free, with the main bar opposite having 2 steps up, or access via the lift.

BOOKING ACCESS FACILITIES

Headrow House offers PA tickets to customers who may not be able to attend a performance or gig without a friend or support worker. Please contact a member of our team to arrange this.

Unfortunately, Headrow House does not have its own parking facilities.

The two nearest car parks to the venue are NCP Car Park The Core and Templar Street & Edward Street Car Parking, both 0.2 miles or 322 metres away. NCP Car Park The Core can be found on Albion St, Schofields, Leeds LS1 6AD. Templar Street and Edward Street Car Parking can be found on Templar Street & Edward Street, Leeds LS2 7LP.

Blue badge parking spaces can be found on the Headrow, 121 ft or 36 metres from the venue. Here's a link to blue badge parking spaces in Leeds

For taxis and drop offs, there is a space right outside the front of the venue.

Leeds station is 0.5 miles or 805 metres away (New Station St, Leeds, LS1 4DY)

Leeds bus station is 0.3 miles or 483 metres away (Dyer St, Leeds, LS2 7LA)

The Closest bus stop is 85 ft or 25 metres from the venue (The Headrow, Stop H10, Leeds, LS1 6PU)

The venue opens at midday. The performance space opening times differs with each event and can be found on the ticket or online.

If you require early access, please contact the venue to arrange. Upon arrival, you will be greeted by our duty manager or a member of our friendly front of house team. At the box office you will require a physical or online ticket.
